USGA / R & A Rules of Golf Apply

- Local Rules are posted and available at Pro Shop.
- The USGA recommends playing tees based on your average driving distance.
 - Black: 250 yards
 - White: 225 yards
 - Gold: 200 yards
 - Green: 175 yards

ETIQUETTE:

- Please repair ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.
- Proper golf attire is required.
- Each player must have a set of clubs; no sharing.
- Keep carts on paths around tees and greens. Follow all cart directional signs.
- Vermont State Law prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages that are not purchased from Williston Golf Club. Personal coolers are not allowed.

FAST PLAY TIPS:

- Drop your cart partner off at their ball then go to your ball and prepare to hit.
- Park your cart/clubs behind the green nearest to the next tee.
- Leave green immediately after completing hole and record scores on next tee.
- Do not search for lost balls for more than 2 minutes.
- Make a quick pit stop at the turn, 5 minute maximum.

PACE OF PLAY POLICY:

Golf is a four hour game. Play ready golf. Follow pace par provided and please keep up with the group in front of you.

Slow groups will be asked to speed up and may be required to skip a hole to catch up.

Please respect our course rangers' suggestions. Our goal is to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable round. Thanks for your cooperation.
